## WHAT'S CHANGING?

MRTs in Nova Scotia are now regulated and a regulatory college, the NSCMIRTP, was created. The functions of the NSCMIRTP are designed to protect the public and do not prioritize programs and services in support of the practicing MRT or the MRT profession.

Members will need to vote in 2021 on the proposed model wherein the CAMRT will deliver provincial association services through CAMRT-ATL. This model would have a paid advocate on the ground in Atlantic Canada whose job will be ensuring the voice of MRTs is heard and that Atlantic MRTs are supported, recognized and provided with important resources.
