Michelle's clinical and professional experience as a Radiation Therapist, a Medical Dosimetrist, and Educator enabled her to focus on all patients in both the human and veterinary oncology community. Her creativity and innovation resonated daily, and it demonstrated the purpose that Michelle brought forward that resulted in learning opportunities for other individuals. She loved people, she loved to give back, she was a devoted leader, and her energy was contagious by all that had the opportunity to be part of her life. Michelle was a loving mother, daughter, and she leaves a legacy that is deeply felt across the vast ocean and rises above the mountains.

This Scholarship continues Michelle's legacy through those who are committed to developing and expanding their education in radiation oncology. This scholarship will be awarded to a learner currently enrolled in a Radiation Therapy focused entry to practice program or a continuing education program (i.e. Radiation Therapy diploma or degree, graduate studies, other continuing education program including a Medical Dosimetrist program).

Eligibility

Candidates must:

1. Be currently enrolled in a Radiation Therapy focused entry to practice program (diploma or degree) or continuing education program (degree, graduate studies or other continuing education program including a Medical Dosimetry program).
2. Demonstrate creativity/innovation, energy, passion, and a drive to provide excellence in patient care. Proof can be demonstrated through community actions that will translate into the patient care setting and/or through clinical and professional activities.
3. Must hold a current CAMRT student membership or membership in the following categories; Full Practice, Temporary Practice, Non-practicing, International.
4. Please note that the following individuals are not eligible:
 - CAMRTF board members
 - Groups of members or organizations

Application Instructions

Applications must be received by **April 1st**. Late applications will not be reviewed.

Application packages must be sent to the CAMRT Foundation via office.camrtf@gmail.com with **Michelle Elizabeth Kino Memorial Scholarship** in the Subject Line.

Required documents for all applicants

1. Completed application form.
2. Proof of enrollment in an eligible program.
3. Current resume/curriculum vitae.
 - a. Include relevant work history, education, professional development, professional contributions (research, presentations, committees, volunteering), any other relevant volunteer experience (include role and responsibilities).
4. A minimum of two reference letters, attesting to the applicant's creativity/innovation, energy, passion, and drive that will or has supported excellence in patient care in radiation oncology and motivates others
5. Essay outlining prior activities, engagement, and achievements that demonstrate the applicant's creativity/innovation, energy, passion, and drive that will or has influenced patient care in radiation oncology and motivates others (see below directions for the essay).

Directions for the Essay

The purpose of the essay is for applicants to share their activities, engagement, and achievements that demonstrates creativity/innovation, energy, passion, and drive that will or has influenced patient care in radiation oncology and motivated others. Further, the essay should include future personal and professional goals that demonstrate this focus.

1. The essay should be a maximum of 1000 words, double-spaced and in 12-point font.
2. The essay may be in either Word or PDF format. It should be submitted as a separate document along with the application form.
3. Do not include your name on the essay, as it will be blinded for the evaluation process.

* Failure to follow these directions may result in disqualification from the selection process.

Selection process

The CAMRT Foundation Board will delegate the review of applications to a committee.

The committee will base their recommendations on applicants' demonstration of potential influence or proven influence on patient care through creativity/innovation, energy, passion, and drive in practice.

The committee will provide the CAMRT Foundation Board with a recommendation for consideration and approval.

*Please note that incomplete application packages will not be reviewed.

Notification of the decision will occur in the Spring prior to the CAMRTF AGM.

Unsuccessful applicants may reapply the following year if they continue to meet eligibility requirements.

Distribution of funds

The CAMRT Foundation will arrange transfer of the scholarship funds to the recipient, in the amount of \$1,000, shortly after notification.
