



WILLIAM DOERN LEADERS OF TOMORROW SCHOLARSHIP

The CAMRT Foundation is happy to provide the ***William Doern – Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship*** for community oriented, academically outstanding students attending entry-level medical radiation technology programs.

Eligibility

Candidates must:

1. Be currently enrolled in an entry-level medical radiation technology program (radiological technology, radiation therapy, nuclear medicine, magnetic resonance imaging).
2. Have a minimum B (75-85%) average in medical radiation technology core curriculum courses.
3. Produce proof of voluntary efforts in the community.
4. Please note that the following individuals are not eligible:
 - Individuals with a previous certificate or degree in medical radiation technology.

Application deadline

Applications must be received by **April 1st**. Late applications will not be reviewed.

Application packages should be sent to the CAMRT Foundation at email office.camrtf@gmail.com with *William Doern – Leaders of Tomorrow Scholarship* in the Subject Line.

Required documents for all applicants

1. Completed application form.
2. Official transcript issued from institution containing the grades achieved so far in the medical radiation technology program.
3. Essay outlining leadership achievements and community involvement (see below directions for the essay).

Directions for the Essay

The purpose of the essay is for candidates to share their leadership achievements, community engagement activities, and express their future personal and professional goals.

1. The essay should be a maximum of 1000 words, double-spaced and in 12-point font.
2. The essay may be in either Word or PDF format. It should be submitted as a separate document along with the application form.
3. Do not include your name on the essay, as it will be blinded for the evaluation process.

* Failure to follow these directions may result in disqualification from the selection process.

Selection process

The CAMRT Foundation Board will delegate the review of applications to a committee. The committee will provide the CAMRT Foundation Board with recommendations for consideration and approval.

Applications are weighted on the following criteria:

1. Application leadership essay (60%)
2. Academics (40%)

*Please note that incomplete application packages will not be reviewed.

Notification of the decision will occur prior to the CAMRT Foundation Annual General Meeting where an announcement of the recipients will be made.

Unsuccessful applicants may reapply the following year if they continue to meet eligibility requirements.

Distribution of funds

The CAMRT Foundation will arrange transfer of the scholarship funds to the recipient, in the amount of \$1,000, shortly after the announcement of the successful applicant at the CAMRT Foundation Annual General Meeting.
