Course Mentorship/Instructorship

The CAMRT seeks an **instructor** for **Winter** term (January) on an ongoing basis for our CT Imaging 2 – Radiation Therapy and CT Imaging 3 – Radiation Therapy courses. The successful candidate must have:

- a minimum of five years' experience in the practice of CT Imaging, including recent or on-going clinical experience in radiation therapy
- be a certified, Canadian medical radiation therapist with a strong working knowledge of CT sectional anatomy and image evaluation
- knowledge of current and emerging CT practices and protocols
- experience in CT Sim & CT Planning
- experience creating multiple choice questions
- availability to grade assignments, respond to questions and assist (this course is not entirely multiple-choice graded) from January onwards according to term dates/deadlines
- preferred: the candidate holds a CTRT certificate.

The CAMRT also seeks an **instructor** for **Winter** term (January) on an ongoing basis for our **Breast Imaging 2 course.** The successful candidate must have:

- a minimum of five years' experience in the practice of breast imaging, including recent or ongoing clinical experience in breast imaging
- be a certified, Canadian medical radiation technologist with a strong working knowledge of breast anatomy and image evaluation
- knowledge of current and emerging breast imaging practices and protocols
- experience creating multiple choice questions
- availability to grade assignments, respond to questions and assist (this course is not entirely multiple-choice graded, but that is planned from late 2026) from January onwards according to term dates/<u>deadlines</u>
- preferred: the candidate holds a CBIS or CBID certificate
- preferred: experience in peer review of courses

Volunteering

Dosimetry Certificate Committee

We are seeking a qualified medical radiation therapist to join the Dos Committee as a specialist in dosimetry/radiation therapy planning. The Certificate in Dosimetry (CDC) relies on experienced volunteer committee member review. The successful candidate must have:

- a minimum of three years' experience in the practice of dosimetry, including on-going clinical experience in dosimetry as a certified, Canadian medical radiation therapist
- knowledge of current and emerging dosimetry practices and protocols
- be a full practice CAMRT member
- preferred: the candidate holds a CAMRT CDC Certificate or CMD, completion of CAMRT dosimetry full-length courses; east-coast, Atlantic or territorial representation sought to ensure committee balance.

Interventional Radiology Certificate Committee

We are seeking a medical radiation technologist with demonstrated knowledge and competence in the field of **IR (RTR)** to join the IR Committee. The CIR program is intended to promote standards of excellence within this clinical area, and to identify those who have met a nationally recognized standard in the practice of IR. Interested candidates must:

- be a certified, Canadian medical radiation technologist in radiological technology with a strong working knowledge of IR
- work in IR clinically, including having a minimum of 3 years' recent experience working in IR
- have an awareness of current and emerging practices and technological developments in IR
- preferred criterion: completion of the CAMRT CIR Certificate; completion of CAMRT's IR-related courses, prairie or territorial representation sought to ensure committee balance.

For all volunteer positions in certificate program committees:

- → Interested candidates are encouraged to contact CAMRT if they are interested in reviewing the certificate outlines or if they would like more details on the scope of work. This is not a paid position.
- → All interested candidates should submit a comprehensive CV, as well as 1 written reference and a cover letter (both of which outline how they meet the above criteria) to cpd@camrt.ca by November 30, 2025.

Committee member duties include:

- assessing final clinical competency documents from candidates (this is a busy program, with document reviews several times a month)
- annual attendance at a 2–3-day meeting, virtual or in-person (often Ottawa), with hybrid options and travel funding support available
- providing expert review when assessing certificate program requirements and practices
- advising on future directions of the program, as required
- each committee membership term is 3 years and is renewable for another 3-year term.
